

Pioneer Days 2008 Guidelines for Food Booths  
Bannock County Fairgrounds  
July 19, 2008  
(As of June 11, 2008)

1. Set up is Friday evening after 6 p.m. or EARLY Sat. Morning BEFORE 10:00 a.m. ALL vehicles must be removed from the paved part or grass area of the grandstand area by then!
2. Each ward or unit that has a food booth is responsible for own set up and clean up.
3. Electricity is limited. Those that require it need to let Todd Nelson know so he can arrange to have it for you. You supply cords, etc....
4. Assignments will be made as to what food you are serving. And prices are to be set by Todd Nelson. All you have to do is provide the manpower and cooking skills to fix /cook/serve and collect the money! Dan Heiner will come around several times during the day to collect money and give you change.
5. Fire Extinguishers and first aid kits need to be in each booth.
6. NO vehicles allowed after 10:00 a.m. to unload, etc.!!!!
7. A check in and assignment of spaces for all the participants in the park activities will be located in the south fairground entrance also a print out is available on the internet on the official web site of the pioneer days. [www.pioneerdaycelebration.com](http://www.pioneerdaycelebration.com)
