Pioneer Day Parade Guidelines for 2010

- 1. A registration form for each float or entry must be submitted by July 18, 2010 by 5:00 pm. The on-line registration form must be completely filled out and approved. A list of received applications and the status of each application can be found online at www.PioneerDayCelebration.com under the "parade" section.
- 2. The Pioneer Day Committee reserves the right to deny participation to any entry deemed controversial, inappropriate or for any other reason not needing to be specified.
- 3. All entries desiring to be judged must arrive at the Holt Arena parking Lot between 7:30 am and 8:00 am on July 24, 2010 and must be ready to be judged by 8:00 am. Marching teams, horses, political, and other entries should arrive prior to 9:00 am. Look for parade officials to help you find your line up position or print off a copy from the website.
- 4. Vehicles not intended to pull floats should be kept away from the assembly area in a designated parking area except to unload persons or items necessary to complete the float. Please remove the vehicle promptly after unloading.
- 5. Those arriving with horses or other animals should pay particular attention to potential problems with waste elimination and behavior. If you have horses (or other animals) in the parade, you must provide someone to clean up the staging area, follow you along and clean up during and along the parade route, as well as in the Union Pacific Parking Lot. THIS IS A CITY ORDINANCE. You will be fined for non-compliance.
- 6. The parade will start promptly at 10:00 am.
- 7. All parade entries that intend to distribute candy or other items must comply with the following:
 - a. No items can be 'thrown'. Candy must be 'handed' to recipients. THIS IS A CITY ORDINANCE.
- 8. Commercial and political entries are allowed in the parade and are required to pay a commercial entry fee of \$25. Banners on these vehicles are permitted.
- 9. All participants are to continue moving at a steady pace. Performance groups are not allowed to stop and perform lengthy routines that disrupt the flow of the parade.
- 10. Violations to any of these guidelines may be reason to be removed from this parade as well as not to be permitted to participate in future Pioneer Day Celebration parades.
